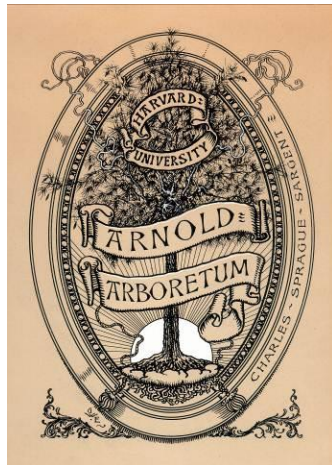

**Abstract:** Mounting Records consist of notebooks kept by Herbarium staff. These notebooks document plant specimens received and processed for deposit into either Arnold Arboretum Herbarium or Gray Herbarium located at Harvard University Herbaria. Details include total number of specimens mounted on a particular date, their origin, and destination repository. This particular method of record keeping began in 1964 and continues to the present day.

**Provenance:** Staff Mounting Records from 1964 to 1985 and Volunteer Mounting Records from 1984 to 1995 were transferred from Ida Hay papers in 2012. Staff Mounting Records from 1986 to 2011 and Volunteer Mounting Records from 1995 to 2008 were deposited as completed into the Archives by Susan Hardy Brown, Curation Staff Member. Deposits continue on an ongoing basis.

### **Historical Note:**

The [Herbarium of the Arnold Arboretum](#) was established in 1872, and contains more than a million specimens housed within the [Harvard University Herbaria](#) in Cambridge, Massachusetts. The Cultivated Herbarium in the Arboretum's Hunnewell Building currently holds 130,000 specimens, representing mainly temperate plants of cultivated origin. Fifty thousand of these specimens document extant or former accessions from the Arboretum's living collections and can be searched on the [specimen database](#).

Herbarium Mounting Records in this collection have been kept by Herbarium Staff since 1964. These notebooks provide an accurate count of specimens received, processed, mounted, and deposited into either Arnold Arboretum Herbarium or the Gray Herbarium at Harvard University Herbaria in Cambridge. Notebook data is recorded into electronic spreadsheets by Curation staff. Along with record keeping, this data is used for annual reports and grant applications. Each notebook is deposited into the Archives when complete.
